‘ From Ground Water to Acid Mine Water ’

April 24th and 27th 2018 in Mikkeli, Finland

Dear Colleague,

I hope you are doing well wherever you are sitting or working at the moment.

Lappeenranta University of Technology and IMWA are giving a Mine Water Short Course (“From Ground Water to Acid Mine Water”) between April 24th and 27th 2018 in Mikkeli, Finland. This Short Course will focus on general mining aspects, which help to understand the formation of mine water. It will cover key aspects of mine water geochemistry and the management as well as treatment of polluted mine water. The lecturer will be Prof Dr habil Christian Wolkersdorfer, SARChI Chair in Acid Mine Water Treatment and Finnish Distinguished Professor for Mine Water Management (you can find details about the course on the website).

The first three days are directed to theoretical issues and the fourth day will introduce you to mine water flow measurements with the salt dilution method.

Regular registration fees are 850 € for the four days. Discounts for IMWA / FBW members (650 €) and registered students (300 € / 250 €) are available (Registration includes course material and coffee/tea breaks. Lunch not included).
