**CALL FOR PAPERS**

**CONGRESS THEME**

Innovation is not just a term of the worlds of business and technology but of universities and educational units as well. The question still remains: what kind of people innovate? What kind of environment best supports them when they are putting forward their creative ideas? To answer questions like these there is a need for multidimensional analysis. The key words are innovation by international and interdisciplinary collaboration in the context of Higher level Education.

In order to obtain a more comprehensive view into :

1. the civilization as a product of education and experience,
2. the contribution of Educational systems to civilization – level change,
3. education innovation challenge in 2019

we will take under consideration all the above seemingly contradictory fields, trying to highlight the different sides of the same coin!

If you feel that you can contribute to the scholarly debate on such questions or, you are looking for relevant and thoughtful answers, then make sure that you will be in **Greece** for the **International Congress on Management of Educational Units in November 2019**.

### **CONGRESS INFORMATION**

The ICOMEU 2019 International Congress is hosted and organized by the **Alexander Technological Educational Institute of Thessaloniki**. The units responsible for the Congress organization are: a) the Program of Postgraduate Studies on Management of Educational Units, and b) the Department of Business Administration.

The congress will take place at Thessaloniki in **Greece**. Thessaloniki was named after the sister of Alexander the Great and is one of the oldest cities in Europe; a few years ago the city celebrated 2400 years since establishment. Thessaloniki is a seaside port city, has served as European Capital of Culture in 1997, and is well-known for its cosmopolitan style, rich gastronomic appeal, and vibrant night-life. The city has a rich culture and history influenced by the classic Greek, the Roman, the Byzantine and the Ottoman eras.

The state-of-the-art congress program includes: a) a high quality scientific research track with refereed paper presentations, b) cutting-edge keynote speakers and roundtables from the academia, and the public sector, c) a student paper presentations track and a PhD workshop.

### **SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS**

The research track of the congress will be exploring the overall theme of “Education-Civilization- Innovation at crossroads- the way ahead” and will focus on sub-themes like:

- Civilization as a product of education
- Innovation and education
- Educational Changes
- Multicultural educational environments
- Globalization of Education
- Technology and Education
- Educational Tourism
- Skills of future educators
- Future trends in Education and Training
- Vocational Training

Submitted abstracts should be relevant with the overall congress theme objectives and at least one of the congress sub-themes, should be written in English, and should be submitted in time (see below for “important dates”) All contributions must be original (i.e. not been published elsewhere), follow academic writing, structure and methodology.

Submissions will be **blind-refereed** by at least **two anonymous reviewers** who will decide if the proposed abstracts will be accepted or not. All abstracts will be included in conference proceedings. Should a delegate wish to have his paper included in the special issue (see next paragraph) a full paper of 6 – 8 pages written in English and following the author guidelines should be submitted.

### **PROCEEDINGS & FURTHER PUBLICATION OPPORTUNITIES**

All accepted and presented papers will be included in the official congress proceedings. The proceedings will be published professionally in electronic form with an ISBN and will be available for distribution during the congress. Each registered congress delegate will receive one free copy of the congress proceedings.

Authors of selected congress papers will have the opportunity to publish their work at a **special issue** of the international scientific **Journal of Contemporary Education Theory & Research (JCETR)**

### **CONGRESS LANGUAGES**

The official congress languages are Greek and English. There will be sessions in Greek and/or English.

### **IMPORTANT DATES**

Submission of Abstracts (between 500 & 700 words, plus main references): **30th of June 2019**

Evaluation of abstracts and communication with authors: **15<sup>th</sup> of July 2019**

Submission of final papers (if applicable) and communication with authors: **30th of July 2019**

\* Authors of accepted abstracts will be informed about the submission specifications/guidelines for the full papers. Only papers presented at the congress will be included in the official congress proceedings.
