15. Course aims:

- learn about basic knowledge about frazeology,
- direct contact with language facts. Criticism of scientific literature,
- Improve the intellectual skills of students, in terms of applying the acquired knowledge in the teaching process,
- improve communication skills of students, in written and verbal form,
- improve student skills for individual and team work,
- improve the skills of students for continental work, throughout the year,
- students need to understand the change in the education system: students are in the center of the teaching process, in contrast to the old school system, students need to have an active participation in all teaching activities, and also need to have two-way communication with the teacher / assistant.

16. Learning outcomes:

Successful students who have continuously implemented their responsibilities during the teaching process will be qualified to:

- use available literature related to this course,
- understand the basic issue,
- solve problems, individually and in the team, and present them in written and verbal form,
- Understand the importance of this course, which is indispensable in furthering their own scientific education and pedagogical and professional work,
- passes the exam in the first exam period at the end of the semester.

18. Learning methods:

For the purpose of effective teaching and achievement of course objectives and student competences, students will use the following methods during class:

- Lectures,
- Theoretical (auditor) exercises,
- individual and team / group work.

19. Assessment methods:

As part of their obligations, the students are required to write a seminar paper which will encompass specific topics from the syllabus. The seminar paper, which represents an individual literary scientific work, is handed in in written form for review and assessment, and it is then presented orally. A student can receive 0-70 points for a written and presented seminar paper. In addition, a student can receive 0-30 points in a semester for continuous activity in class.

In order for a student to pass the course, they need to receive a minimum of 54 points in total, with a minimum of 40 points in the seminar paper – the individual literary scientific paper.

20. Assessment components:

The minimum number of points required to pass the exam is 54:

54-63=6 (six)

64-73=7 (seven)

74-83=8 (eight)

84-93=9 (nine)

94-100=10 (ten)

with 6 being the lowest and 10 being the highest grade.
