18. Learning methods:

For the purpose of efficient teaching and achievement of the course objectives and competences of students, the following methods will be used during the course:

19. Assessment methods:

B) Oral: oral exam

To check the adopted knowledge will be used:

- written method and
- oral method

The written method includes written knowledge test. Knowledge testing will be realized through questions and answers related to the content of the subject. It will be done after the realization of scheduled lectures and exercises. The minimum number of points for passing on the written part of the exam (test) is 26. The oral method will be applied to students who score less than the minimum number of points (26) and those students who express wishes to gain a grade through oral exam. Students who do not get the minimum number of points on the test (26) are obliged to approach the oral exam.
