**15. Course aims:**

To introduce students with basic theoretical-practical knowledge in the field of political theories of doctrines and ideologies such as: conservatism, liberalism, Christian democracy, fascism-nationalism, new right and social democracies.

**16. Learning outcomes:**

Acquiring basic theoretical and practical knowledge in the field of political theories, doctrines and ideologies such as: conservatism, liberalism, Christian democracy, fascism-nationalism, new right and social democracy.

**17. Course content:**

- Introduction to Political Theories, Doctrine and Ideologies:  
 Conservatism: Theories of Conservatism, the Phase of European Conservatism (Traditional Conservatism 1789-1848, Traditional German Conservatism, Civil National Conservatism 1848-1918, Anti-democratic Thought or Third Stage of Conservatism 1918-1933, Neo-Conservatism 1945).  
 - Liberalism: the Historical Phase of Liberalism (Early Liberalism 1750-1850, liberalism of established citizenship 1860-1890, liberalism 1890-1933, neo liberalism in 1930).  
 - Christian Democracy: Elements of Doctrine-Ideology of Christian Democracy, Relation to Other Political Doctrines and Ideologies, Historic Phase of Christian Democracy (Formation of Church-Social Doctrine and Christian Democratic Movement 1891-1932), Christian Democracy Renewal and Descending Tendency 1947.  
 - Fascism-National Socialism: French Action (Charles Maurras, 1868-1952), Italian Fascism, National Socialism, Neofascism-Neofascism;  
 - New Right: Concept and Development of the New Right,  
 Social Democracy: Social Democracy and Germany (period 1848-1914, period 1914-1945, period 1945), social democracy as doctrine-ideology.

**18. Learning methods:**

- Interactive lectures;
- Interactive group learning - group work and presentations;
- Seminars from literature.

**19. Assessment methods:**

- Continuous monitoring and evaluation of student activities;
- Making independent written work or preparing thematic and oral presentations.
